STAYSAIL RV PARK CLOSING OCTOBER 15, 2017

The Staysail RV Park will permanently close this fall to make room for Windjammer Park improvements.

Last year, the City of Oak Harbor worked with the community to create a plan for updating Windjammer Park in coordination with a Community Advisory Group. The City found that modernizing the RV Park would require the City to greatly reduce the number of RV stalls provided. City Council and the Community Advisory Group recommended removing the RV Park to make room for a gateway pavilion, restrooms, basketball courts, a large kitchen, and more.
